



The new 3 metre All-Game Barrier fencing is heavily galvanized to guarantee durability in the harsh African conditions. There are two variations available in this range to cater for every ones needs.

The first variation has a horizontal line spacing of 100mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 300mm for the lower 1.3-metre section. The next 300mm(height) directly above this area has 2 sections with a horizontal line spacing of 150mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 300mm each. The remaining 1.4-metre upper section has a horizontal line spacing of 200mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 300mm. A 100m roll of this variation weighs only 87.10kg,

making distribution easier.

The second variation has a horizontal line spacing of 100mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 150mm for the lower 1.3-metre section. The next 300mm(height) directly above this area has 2 sections with a horizontal line spacing of 150mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 150mm each. The remaining 1.4-metre upper section has a horizontal line spacing of 200mm(height) by a vertical line spacing of 150mm. This is ideal for farmers who wish to keep smaller animals from breaching their perimeters at ground level as the vertical line wires are in closer proximity to each other (150mm) and would hinder any type of animal trying to crawl through. A 100m roll of this variation weighs only 119.43kg, making distribution easier.

As with all Bonnox quality products, erecting the fence is easier, less time consuming and less labour intensive. Bonnox recommends the following guidelines be adhered to when erecting the All-Game Barrier fence:

Posts: 3.8m length, cemented 750mm - 800mm into the ground, 98m apart, each post should have 2 stays.

Stays: 4.2m length, attached to the post and cemented into the ground with a 35' angle.

Y-standards: 3.65m length, knocked 600mm into the ground every 10m.

Droppers: 3.05m length. Optional attached to the fence every 10m. **Clamp bar** of 3.2m with 4 ton ratchet pullers to be used for straining.




